


## Before You Leave Town ...

Traveling out of town for business or pleasure? Or do you have a dependent in college or living out of the area? Be aware of how CDPHP® covers out-of-area care.

Before you or your family member leave home:

- ▶ Download the My CDPHP app. You can use the Find-A-Doc search tool to locate participating providers, urgent care centers, and labs. You can also view your member ID card as well as check your medical and pharmacy benefits.
- ▶ Make a list of your prescriptions and keep it in your wallet.
- ► Carry your CDPHP member ID card in the enclosed sleeve. The sleeve provides information on what to do when you need out-of-area urgent or emergency care.

**Most importantly:** To limit your financial liability, make sure you contact CDPHP member services at the number on your ID card before you seek services from an out-of-area provider. They can answer your questions regarding coverage for you and your dependents.
