Breast pumps are a covered benefit for most plans*

CDPHP covers the purchase of a standard electric breast pump or rental of a hospital-grade breast pump with a **doctor's prescription**. Pumps must be ordered from participating vendors, including, but not limited to:

Get money back for breastfeeding classes

Participate in a breastfeeding class at your local hospital or in the community. Free breastfeeding education is available through **WIC, Alpha Pregnancy Care Center, Burdett Birth Center**, or a local **baby café**. If there is a cost for the class, CDPHP will reimburse the full out-of-pocket cost. To request reimbursement, complete the lactation reimbursement form at cdphp.com/postpartum.



Receive free breastfeeding assistance**

Questions or challenges? Get support from a breastfeeding professional, such as a lactation consultant. CDPHP covers these visits in full. To find a lactation consultant near you, search “lactation” on **CDPHP Find-A-Doc**, or ask your OB/GYN, child’s pediatrician, or place of delivery for their recommendations. The CDPHP Care Team can also help you find support and can be reached at **1-888-942-3747**. If out-of-pocket expenses occur, complete the lactation reimbursement form at cdphp.com/postpartum.

** One pump is covered per pregnancy. Participation in these services is dependent on plan type. Please check your member contract or call the number on your ID card to see if you’re eligible. Medicaid members can obtain a breast pump with a prescription through NYRx, The Medicaid Pharmacy Program. For questions or more information, call **1-800-342-3005**.*
